

Lake Charles Yacht Club Harbor Rules

1. The wet slips, launch area and boat ramp at the Lake Charles Yacht Club are open to the membership to enjoy and utilize their personal boats.
2. Please do not block the launch ramp or launch pier. Move vehicles and boats as quickly as possible to allow their usage by others.
3. No overnight staying on the launch pier or L dock without Harbor Master or Board approval.
4. Usage of slips is for members only unless Harbor Master or other board member approves temporary usage of 3 days or less.
5. Any club with reciprocity with LCYC (GYA etc) can utilize our docks with permission of the Harbor Master.
6. Any existing member in good standing may request a wet slip for their sailboat by filling out the form and submitting it to the Harbor Master.
7. A new member to the club may request a wet slip for a sailboat.
8. All slips shall be assigned by the Harbor Master before occupying the slip.
9. An existing member that is current on dues and maintains a sailboat in a slip MAY at the Harbor Masters discretion acquire a 2nd slip for a sailboat or powerboat.
10. All boats must be maintained in the slips to the approval of the Harbor Master and LCYC.
11. All vessels berthed in slips must comply with all the rules of the club relating to storage of vessels.
12. All vessels berthed in slips will be required to comply with LDWF and Coast Guard rules and regulations.
13. Slips will not automatically transfer to new owners in case of a vessel sale or transfer. New owner must request a slip assignment.
14. Powerboat slips may be acquired with the recommendation of the Harbor Master and approval of the LCYC Board.
15. No member will be allowed to have more than 2 wet slips.
16. All boats in slips must be maintained and ship shape. All propulsion needs to be running or the Harbor Master needs to be notified with a timeline for fixing.
17. All propulsion needs to be running or the Harbor Master needs to be notified with a timeline for remediation.
18. Electrical outlets for either 15A or 30A are at most slips. These are not currently metered so do not abuse them. No air conditioners are to be in operation when boat is not being utilized.
19. Water is available at most docks. Please turn off when not in use. If a water line is broken or valve not working, please report to Harbor Master or Board. Water hoses are not provided by the club.
20. This is a sailing club first. Any powerboats that are in a slip will be required to be removed if a sailboat is on the waiting list that will fit in that slip.
21. If there is a waiting list for wet slips, any member not complying with rules will be asked to remove their boat to allow a sailboat in the slip.
22. Liveboards are allowed only with the recommendation of the Harbor Master and approval by the LCYC Board.
